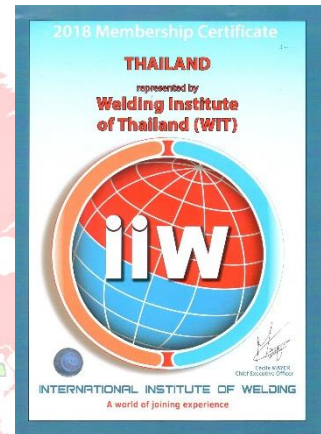
Introduction

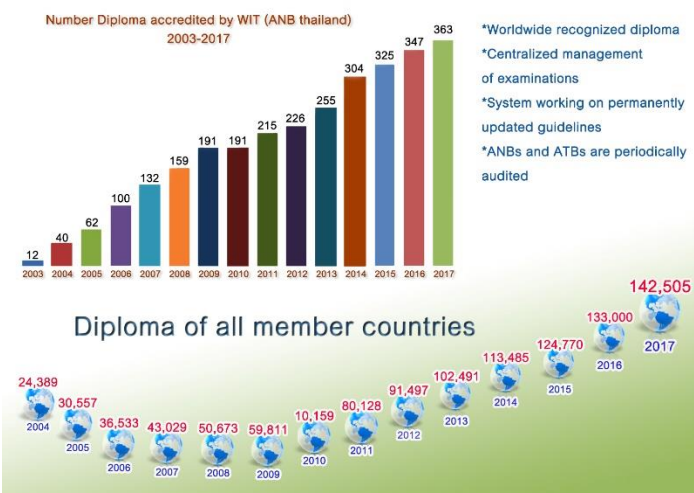
Mission & Objectives

Education, Training and Certification activities

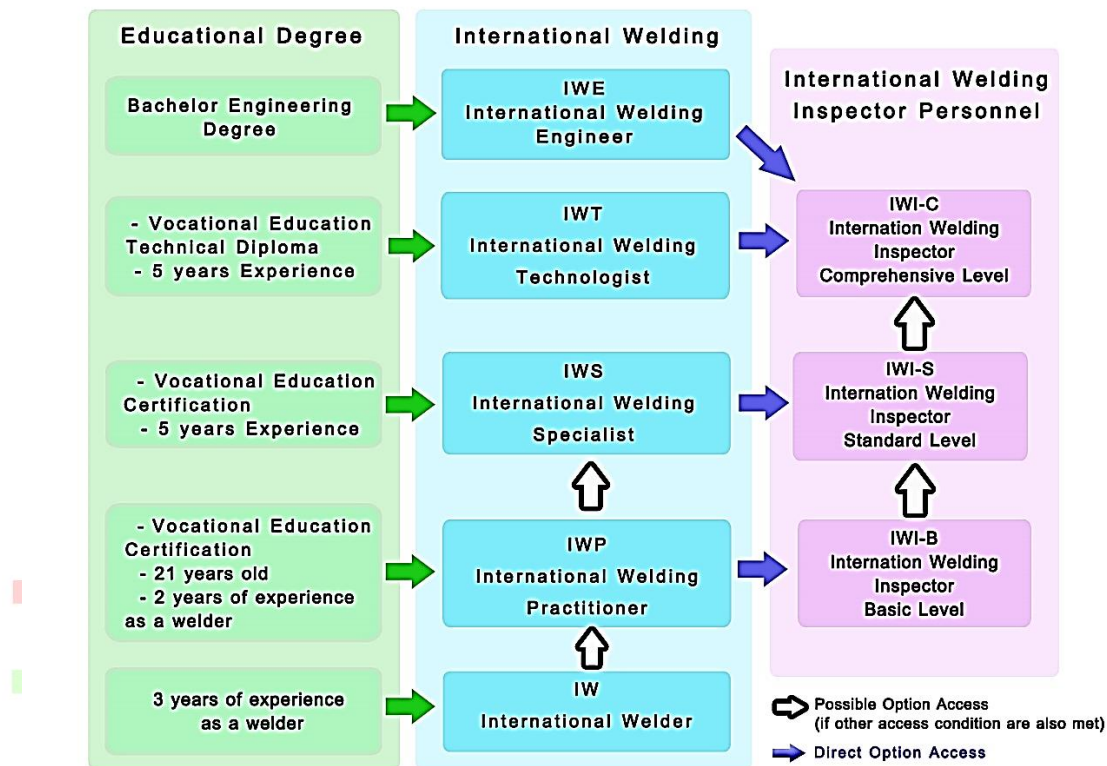


1) IIW Thailand conducts an IIW examination all over Thailand to confer certification equivalent to Graduate Engineering Degree of a University as recognized by the HRD Department

2) ANB - The institute is the only Authorised Nominated Body (ANB) of the International Institute of Welding in Thailand for award of International Diplomas to Welding Personnel at various, which are globally recognized and accepted. The Diplomas offered are for Welding Coordination and Welding Inspection conforming to the requirement of ISO 14731. International Welder curriculum is also

conducted at Approved Training Body (ATB) of ANB - Thailand. ANB - Thailand also awards Welder Certification and Approval test against ISO 9606, EN 287 & ASME Sec IX.
